- 3. Past District VII Commander Burke conducted the Officer's Obligation Oath for; SVC Collins, PHC Member Grubbs, and POW/MIA Search Team Member Kempski.

- 1. Surgeon Grimm advised names of contacts for Veterans Support Committee. He advised Members to notify him or JVC Rogers if they know of a Veteran admitted to any Hospital. He spoke of the need for Veterans to accomplished a special power of attorney if admitted to hospital when there is no immediate next of kin.
- 2. Comrade Larson spoke of the need for additional volunteers for the Clark Veterans Cemetery Honor Guard Team.
